Many like-minded people meet at these unique events, and we know first-hand that many party the night away!





## Getting to the Chateau

#### BY FERRY/CAR

#### **BY TRAIN**

The nearest train station is at Laval which is on the direct line from Paris and Rennes and served by fast TGV trains. Leaving Paris Montparnasse the direct service takes under 1½ hours. From Rennes takes between 25 and 40 minutes and leaves frequently.

#### **BY PLANE**

The nearest airport is Rennes with flights from London-Gatwick.
Flights to Rennes from other locations are seasonal and do not fly in March. Once at Rennes, a train will take you to Laval (see above).
